A limited number of tickets will be available online only from April 11-

April 18. These tickets are subject to a late fee.

Grand March: The Grand March will be held at the Great Hall located in the 180 East Fifth

building at the corner of Fifth and Jackson Streets in historical Lowertown Saint Paul. Plan on arriving for the Grand March around 5:45. Couples will descend to the main level of the Great Hall via a double escalator. Couples will be

introduced and in the spotlight as they begin their descent on the escalator. The Grand March is scheduled to run for about an hour (6:00 to 7:00); however, the Grand March will continue only as long as there are couples waiting to be

introduced. <u>DO NOT</u> wait until 7:00 to arrive for the Grand March—it may be over

because there were no couples to be introduced. Last year the Grand March finished by 6:50. We have planned for many photo opportunities for parents and friends as the couples make their way through the crowd on the zig-zagging

walkway.

Prom Pictures: David Bank Studios will be taking prom pictures just before Grand March starting

at 5:45 and continuing until 7:00. They will resume taking pictures at 8:30 and continue until 9:30. Picture packet information will be available in the Student Services office during ticket sales until the date of prom and when tickets are dispersed. Prom pictures should be ready for return soon after prom. We will have

an announcement when pictures are ready.

Dinner Plans: The Great Hall must be converted from grand march set-up to dance floor set-up

immediately following the Grand March. Your dinner reservations should be

sometime between the Grand March and the beginning of the dance. 180 East Fifth must be cleared of all people during the transition. Please do not come before 8:15 as there is a very small waiting area. The lobby of the building is not large enough

for many students to wait for long periods of time.

The Dance: The dance will be held from 8:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

Once students enter 180 East Fifth, they must remain in the Great Hall dance area on the bottom floor. After students and guests have checked in for the dance they may not leave and re-enter. No one will be admitted to the dance after 10:00.

Complimentary snacks and beverages will be served at the dance.

Students

- You are responsible for your behavior at prom.
- You are expected to follow all Minnesota State High School League and Forest Lake Area Schools rules regarding the use of controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, and appropriate behavior.
- You do not have to spend an excessive amount of money to have fun at prom.
- You do not have to rent a limousine or bus for transportation.
- You do not have to use alcohol or any other drug to have fun before, during or after prom.
- You should not host or attend a party at a hotel, motel, condo or cabin after prom.
- You have the capability of making prom a positive memory.

Parents

- You are encouraged to place a reasonable limit on promexpenditures.
- You do not have to believe the "everyone is doing it" routine because not everyone is doing it.
- You do have the right to know where your son/daughter is going to be throughout the entire evening.
- You do have the right to restrict your son/daughter from attending certain prom events such as hotel, motel, condo, or cabin parties without supervision.
- You are encouraged to clearly state your expectations about your child's behavior on prom night.
- You may want to meet with other parents to plan safe post-prom activities.
- You are encouraged to make certain that you know your child's prom date.
- You will be called to pick your son/daughter up from prom if he/she is violating any school rules regarding behavior or the use of a controlled substance.
- You are encouraged to contact the parents hosting any prom party your child may attend.

From the North

Take 35E South to the Wacouta St. exit. Follow Wacouta St. to 6th St. and turn right. Follow 6th St. to Jackson St. and turn left. One block to 5th St. and turn left.

From the South

Take 35E North to Kellogg Blvd. exit. Turn right at the top of the ramp. Follow Kellogg Blvd. through downtown to Robert St. and turn left. Go two blocks to 5th St. and turn right. One block to building.

From the East

Take 94E to the 6th St. exit. Follow 6th St. to Jackson St. and turn left. One block to 5th St. and turn left.

From the West

Take 94E to the 5th St. exit. Follow 5th St. through downtown until it intersects with Jackson St. Go through the Jackson St. intersection and you will see the entrance to the 180 East Fifth on the right.
